TotalEx® RTU Brush, Grass & Weed Killer with 1 Touch Power Sprayer Virterra

is a non-selective herbicide. It controls most annual and perennial grasses, including lawn grasses, broadleaf weeds such as chickweed, ragweed, knotweed, poison ivy, Canada thistle, milkweed, bindweed and most brush such as poplar, alder, maple and raspberry (i.e. virtually anything that is green and growing). It is absorbed by the leaves and moves throughout the stem and roots to control the entire plant. Mature perennial weeds should be treated after seed heads, flowers or fruit appear. All plants are most easily controlled in the young, actively growing, seedling stage.

TotalEx® RTU Brush, Grass & Weed Killer with 1 Touch Power Sprayer Virterra

wilts and browns plants within 48 hours. Plants usually dry up within 7 to 14 days. There is no soil activity and will not run off to affect nearby vegetation. To ensure that it gets down to the roots, avoid tillage or disturbing the treated area for 7-10 days after treatment or as directed below. Make sure spray contacts only those plants that you want to kill as the spray will damage or kill any desirable plants it contacts. Do not spray in windy conditions. Spray only until foliage is wet, but not to the point of run-off. Heavy rainfall immediately after application may wash the chemical off the foliage and repeat treatment may be required. Do not apply if rainfall is forecast for the time of application. Use a repeat application on any seedlings that re-grow from seeds.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Cut tie on holster, remove sprayer from the holster and unwrap. Uncoil flex tube and straighten. Remove cap from the bottle. Insert tube into the opening and install cap from the sprayer. When ready to use ensure the sprayer switch is in the ON position. Select STREAM or SPRAY by turning the nozzle before use. Stand close to weed. Adjust nozzle to desired spray pattern. Point sprayer away from body and press trigger to begin spraying. Wet the weed with one or two short bursts. Repeat if necessary. Hold trigger for continuous spraying. Do not water for 24 hours. For further sprayer use directions read the instructions included with the sprayer. Keep the sprayer switch in LOCK position when storing or changing fluid bottles or batteries. Store sprayer apparatus in holster when not in use. See holster for additional sprayer instructions.

How to Use: This product is ready-to-use. Ensure uniform and complete spray coverage until foliage is wet, but not to the point of run-off. 5 L treats 100 m² (10 x 10 paces, 1 pace = ~ 1 metre).

Undesirable vegetation control around buildings, lawn trimming/edging, patio weed control, vacant lots, storage & recreational areas, driveways, hard to mow areas and other similar areas: Apply to vigorously growing plants. Apply to annual weeds anytime after emergence. For perennial weeds apply after seed heads, flowers or berries appear.

Weed control around trees/shrubs/ornamentals: Apply around base in a neat fashion. Avoid spray or drift contact with foliage, stems or green bark of desirable plants.

Lawn/garden renovation: For best results on lawns, skip one mowing prior to treatment. Allow at least 3 days after treatment before disturbing the soil and/or replanting.

Brush control: Apply after leaves are fully expanded. Treat trees and brush up to 1.5 m in height only; for taller trees and brush, cut back to 1.5 m or cut down and spray regrowth. Controls most brush such as poplar, alder, maple and raspberry.

REUSE AND REFILL INSTRUCTIONS: Do not use this container or sprayer for any product other than those recommended below. Mix only what is required for one application. **For refilling,** remove the sprayer cap and tube. For each **1 litre** of clean water, add the amount of product as given in the following table. Carefully measure the concentrate into empty container, then add water. Reinstall the tube and sprayer cap. Follow **DIRECTIONS FOR USE.**

SPRAYER SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

- The sprayer is shipped to you with Safety Lock in the ON position. Keep the Safety Lock in LOCK position when storing, refilling or changing batteries.
- Straighten pick up tube before attaching sprayer head to container.
- Select SPRAY or STREAM by turning nozzle before use.
- Pull trigger sprayer, wait several seconds for fluid to prime. Apply product to selected areas as outlined on back panel of label under DIRECTIONS FOR USE.
- If spray pattern is inconsistent, the nozzle may be partially blocked. Flush with warm water.
- If the sprayer motor does not run, check batteries for correct polarity in the battery hatch, as shown.
- If the sprayer motor runs, but does not spray – replace old batteries with new batteries.
- The sprayer is packaged with the batteries installed. Condensation may occur during shipment. For best results, remove the batteries, wipe dry and reinstall before use.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

This sprayer is not child-resistant. Keep the Safety Lock in LOCK position when not in use.

ONLY USE THIS SPRAYER WITH TOTALEX GLYPHOSATE PRODUCTS.

DO'S AND DON'TS OF USING THIS SPRAYER:

1. Do flush out nozzle and flex tube with warm water while pressing trigger after use.
2. Do mix only the amount of spray solution needed for one application.
3. Do not place nozzle in mouth.
4. Do not switch sprayer head with any other type of container.

5. Do not ever mix chemicals together.
6. Do not spray towards people, pets, electrical outlets or flames.
7. Do not mix batteries. Never mix old batteries with new. Do not mix Alkaline with standard (carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel cadmium) batteries.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, CAUSES EYE IRRITATION. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. Avoid contact with eyes, clothing or prolonged contact with skin. Wear rubber gloves when handling. Do not allow others such as children and pets on treated areas during application or to re-enter treated areas until spray has dried. Wash immediately after using this product. Remove clothing if contaminated and wash before use.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE: Keep product in original container and store in a cool dry place away from food, seed, and feed.
