

Effective Weed Control

Chateau Herbicide

New last year, Chateau WDG herbicide has proven to be a very effective weed control product in grapes, as well as blueberries and strawberries in the Fraser Valley. A Group 14 product that represented new chemistry when it was introduced, Chateau WDG provides seasonal residual control of many broadleaf weeds. Growers soon found that Chateau WDG is effective, forming a "barrier", activated by rain or irrigation of at least ½ cm of water. They also found it does not affect established weeds, but can be mixed with glyphosate to control existing weeds. It must not come in contact with crop fruit, green bark or foliage, and should not be used on very young plants. The active ingredient flumioxazin is a photosynthesis inhibitor, preventing target plants from making chlorophyll by inhibiting an essential enzyme (the enzyme is called protoporphyrinogen oxidase, for those interested in unpronounceable names). It can be used effectively on coarse and medium textured soils, but will be less effective on soils with very fine texture or high organic matter.

The photo (below) of a tree fruit planting shows a comparison of an application of Chateau WDG on the left, versus another herbicide treatment on the right.





Diurex 80 WDG

If you used Karmex DF in the past, you will be familiar with Diurex 80 WDG. The same active ingredient, diuron, this Group 7 water dispersible granule formulation is for selective weed control in grapes that are at least three years old. It should be applied as

a pre-emergence herbicide, just prior to weed growth. Diurex 80 WDG will control a variety of annual and perennial grasses and broadleaf weeds. Two applications per year are allowed no closer than 90 days apart. Irrigation or rainfall is required to move the chemical into the root zone. Note — this product can be "hot" on coarse soils that are less than 2% organic matter.

Pristine WG

Here are some additions to the label of this effective fungicide for use in grapes: powdery mildew, botrytis grey mold, black rot, fruit and downy mildew, and bunch rot complex (caused by Cladosporium and Aspergillus species).

Pounce 384 EC

Although this is not a new chemical, Pounce 384 EC gained a registration a couple of years ago in grapes for climbing

cutworms. A range of rates is recommended depending on the size of the cutworms. Apply at the first signs of damage within a half meter of the base of the trunk base in the evening.

PreMix for Grapes

The Grape Premix is 3-1-1 plus magnesium, boron and zinc. It was designed to help meet the nutritional needs of grape vines from spring through summer. The value of a premix is simply that it saves you, the producer, mixing time. Just apply one pail per acre (use a more dilute mix on young plants). Start when there are four to six inches of growth, then apply up to four times per season, ending in July.
