Vegol Crop Oil is a new broad spectrum emulsifiable concentrate that serves as an insecticide, miticide and fungicide all in one. It can be used in both roles as a dormant season spray or as a growing season application. It is registered to control a wide variety of insects, mites, and scale insects in many crops, and will also suppress powdery mildew. Like other pesticidal oils, Vegol Crop Oil coats target pests, including eggs, suffocating them. It additionally acts as a repellent to insects (ovipositional and feeding deterrent). The active ingredient in Vegol Crop Oil is a non-GMO food-grade canola oil. It does not persist in the environment and has minimal impact on the environment. Vegol Crop Oil is registered to control aphids, mites, scale,

whiteflies and mealybugs on a very wide range of field vegetables.

Maximizing Production

Gibberellic Acid in Sweet Corn

GroSpurt GS-4 is a gibberellic acid plant growth regulator that is now available for use in a variety of field-grown vegetables, including sweet corn. Gibberellic acid has been used elsewhere in the world for various agricultural uses for decades. It behaves differently in each crop. In the Okanagan Valley, for example, cherry growers use this product every year without fail. It is used to increase fruit size, and no cherry grower lets a year go by without applying it. Blueberry growers in the Fraser Valley began using it last year to improve fruit set. In ornamental flowers, it is used to increase plant size, increase the number of flowers, increase bloom size and other effects. Again, in each plant species, the benefits are different.



In sweet corn, GroSpurt is registered to increase yield and promote resistance to the effects of heat and drought. It is labeled to be applied at

the emergence of the V2 to V6 leaf stage, using a concentration of 20 - 50 ppm. This is equivalent to mixing 50 - 125 mL per 100 L water.

There is one thing to keep in mind when using gibberellic acid on sweet corn. Apparently, gibberellic acid may increase the effects of Group 27 herbicides. If you are growing varieties of sweet corn that are sensitive to Group 27 herbicides, there could be a risk of injury to the corn plants. Herbicides in Group 27 that are registered in sweet corn include Impact, Armezon and Callisto. Check with your seed supplier to confirm if you must be concerned with this combination.

Pesticide Container Collection Program

TerraLink is participating in the CleanFARMS container collection program. This is part of the national industry association Crop Life Canada, which operates this program yearly to help reduce the amount of contaminated plastic that gets buried or burned. To be eligible, containers must be plastic, no bigger than 23 L in size. Empty your containers, triple rinse them and remove the caps and any loose label or plastic wrap material. Then they can be returned to our Abbotsford location.
