### Lawn Care

## Moss Control

**Dogwood 9-3-6 Moss Control**  
@ 10 lbs / 1,000 sq.ft.

Removing dead moss by dethatching (power raking) is recommended for heavy infestations after applying moss control products. Overseed bare patches if necessary.

## Lime

**Dolo-Pril @ 12 lbs / 1,000 sq. ft**

Why apply lime? Acid soils do not allow proper uptake of many nutrients. Applying lime will

raise the pH to a balanced level, while adding Calcium and Magnesium. It is important to apply the correct amount of lime to reach the desired pH level. Dolo-Pril is a fast acting lime, in an easy to use prill form.

# Get to Know Your Soil

A Healthy soil is essential to the health and vigour of any garden. Soil has eight basic properties. Knowing your soil type (that is, its texture) and its other properties is important for three reasons:

- It will enable you to pick the most suitable plants for the type of soil — which is usually more ecologically sound and less costly than trying to redesign soil for unsuitable plants;
- It helps you determine whether the soil needs amendments;
- It can help you make informed decisions about other landscape projects, such as water features and rain gardens.

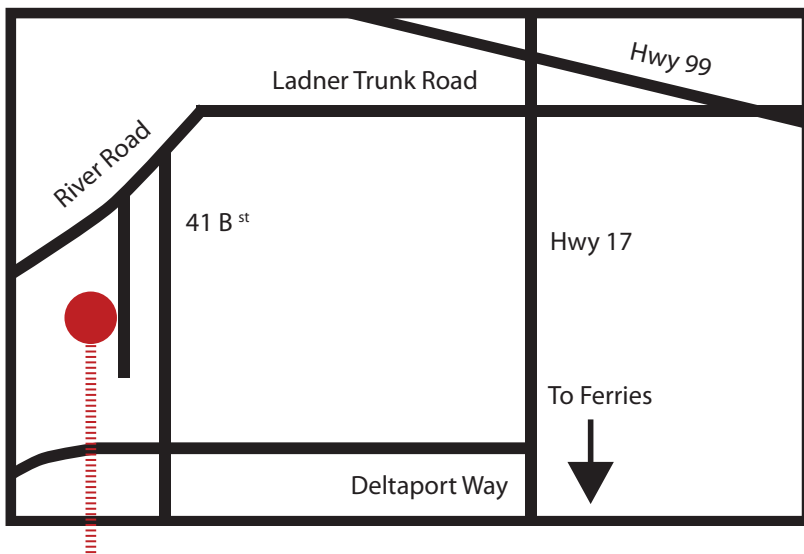
Note that, depending on the yard's size, topography and past uses, soil properties may

vary in different locations in the yard.

As the basis for nutrient management, soil tests are a valuable tool. A chemical analysis may be necessary for accurate information about texture, fertility, and pH, among other properties. We can do basic or detailed soil tests, water and sap analysis. Ask us for further details.
