Most controlled release fertilizers depend on the thickness of their resin coatings to control the release period. The release of nutrients from Nutricote is controlled by the amount of a special chemical release agent in the resin coating. Only the amount of the release agent varies according to the required period of release designated by the various types of Nutricote. Also, Nutricote prills are homogenous.

Nutricote is available in different release periods specified by a 'Type' number. For example, A 'Type' or 'T' number of 100 means that at a constant soil temperature of 25°C, 24 hours a day, a T-100 will release 80% of its nitrogen over a period of about 100 days. For use in container grown nursery stock and greenhouse floriculture.

Incorporate into growing media or use as a topdress application.

13-13-13 and 14-14-14 can be used in greenhouses in conjunction with Plant-Prod Water Soluble Fertilizer.
